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1. **17. Warranty**

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 2 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. Seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

**18. Warranty**

Successful bidder will have to ensure that adequate number of dedicated technical service personals / engine technicians designated / deployed for attending to the Service Request in a time bound manner and for ensuring Timely Rectification / rectification of defects during warranty period, as per Service level agreement indicated in the relevant clause of the bid.

## 19. Warranty

Timely Servicing / rectification of defects during warranty period: After having been notified of the defects / service requirement during warranty period, Seller has to complete the required Service / Rectification within 3 days time limit. If the Seller fails to complete service / rectification with defined time limit, a penalty of 0.5% of Unit Price of product shall be charged as penalty for each week of delay from the seller. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake complete and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the law. सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।
