The India Government Mint, Hyderabad has conducted a Phase-I Online Written Examination for 01 post of Secretarial Assistant on 13.12.2023. A total of 80 candidates have registered in response to the above recruitment advertisement out of which 38 candidates have actually appeared in the online examination held on 13.12.2023.

2. 3. As per Para 7(ii)(b) of the Advertisement, "Those candidates who qualify the online examination as per the above standards fixed by IGMH will be called for a Skill test to be conducted at Hyderabad Test Centre. The candidates must qualify Trade Test/Skill Test."

The Skill test will be of qualifying nature and final selection will be based on the marks obtained by the candidates in Phase-I online examination.


4. It has been tentatively decided to conduct the Phase-II of the selection process During April/May-2024 at Hyderabad. Detailed Instructions with regards to the skill test shall be issued at least 15 days prior to the skill test and shall be uploaded on the website.

5. The candidature of these candidates is PROVISIONAL subject to their being found eligible in all respects.

6. No correspondence/RTI Requests in regard to the marks of the Qualified/Non-Qualified candidates pertaining to the online examination (Phase-I) shall be entertained from the candidates until the entire examination process is completed.

7. All candidates are hereby informed that any canvassing by or on behalf of the candidates or to bring political or other outside influence with regard to their selection/recruitment shall be considered as disqualification and will entail debarment of candidate.
