Scope of Work:

1. **Hi-Skilled Substation Supervisor: 1 Nos:**

1 No's **11KV** or above Licence/Certificate Holder – High Skilled Substation Operator.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- I. Supervision of all 11KV and 33KV basic substation maintenance works in accordance with SOP and Safety protocols.
- II. Operation and Monitoring of the Basic General Substation maintenance works of 33/11KV MSDS, 11KV/440V 3 No's Substations of IGMH.
- III. Operation of 33kV Circuit Breakers, Isolator, LT Panels consisting of AC Bs, etc. according to load requirements and instructions from Electrical Maintenance department.
