5. Balance should have various warning function like Ok, calibration ov erdue, levelling error, and other such warnings to prevent the errors b efore weighing.

6. Balance should have the display with capacitive coloured touchscree n, glove compatible.

7. Instrument should have fully automatic time & temperature controll ed internal adjustment & linearization.

8. Instrument should have data storage facility.

9. Instrument should have sensors to hands-free operation to give com mand on automatic glass draft shield open/close for safe weighing.

10. Instrument should have calibration reminders for calibration and c alibration of test weight to eliminate weighing errors.

11. Instrument should have possibility to block the balance if the balan ce is not calibrated.

12. Instrument should have User Management & Password Protection t o have traceability.

13.
