5. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. 9. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

A) Technical specifications of 300 No's Frame Type Inaugural Set :(He reinafter referred to as 'Frame'):

1) Materials:

a) The overall size of the finished Frame Type Inaugural Set shall be 380mm x 280mm x 15mm approx. (T he reference drawing is uploaded separately in Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC of the document).

b) Coin mounting sheet shall be of 4mm acrylic coloured sheet (preferably milky white colour sheet for design and UV printing) with a provision of two cavities to accommodate the two commemorative coins along with capsule.

c) Coin capsule: The coin is kept in a clear transparent polycarbonate plastic capsule of overall size approximately 50.50mm diameter, to protect it from dust and scratches.

d) Coin mounting sheet i.e. design and UV printed acrylic sheet is surrounded by a golden border and subsequently by a yellow/light yellow margin of high quality paperboard, as shown in reference drawing (Two-toned design with a 4-7 mm golden-colored border separating the coin mounting sheet and frame).

e) Outer frame shall be of compressed wood made mould and Glass shall be used as the cover on the inner body.

f) Frame materials should be resistant to tarnishing, scratching, and fading. Overall, frames shall be manufactured with high finish quality and shall be supplied in proper packing so as to ensure no damage during transportation.

g) The frame should feature a suitable closure mechanism.

h) A strong stand-mounting system, along with wall-mounting hardware, is necessary to ensure versatile display options, whether placed on a table or mounted on a wall.

2) Image and text matter to be printed:

a) The print design shall be provided by IGMH in PDF format, i.e. the design matter, UV portion, Laser cutting drawing for cavity, shall be provided in 3 separate pages.

b) The design print and UV print should match exactly, with no visible overlaps and printing errors etc.

c) The color of the frame should match exactly as per the design provided by IGMH.

3) Frame Design:

a) The frame design should be simple and elegant, complementing the commemorative coins.

b) The cavities to accommodate the coin capsules must be cut on laser cutting machine to ensure clean finish, the location and size shall be as per the design.

c) Incorporate a scratch-free and scratch-resistant clear panel (glass) to allow easy viewing of the commemorative coins.

d) Once the commemorative coins are placed, they remain secure and do not rotate.

4) Dimensions:

a) The frame dimensions should adhere to the provided reference drawing, with accommodation for two commemorative coins.

b) Coin Compartments: Dimensions to precisely fit the specific commemorative coins.

5) Additional Requirements:

a) Proper packing of frames with 2 commemorative coins each and final delivery packing with bubble wrapping are the supplier's responsibility.

b) Commemorative coins shall be fitted in the premises of IGMH.

c) All the required packing material for final packing including bubble wrapping of the frames has to be arranged by the firm.

6) Acceptance Criteria:

a) The first sample of complete frame provided by the supplier must be approved before proceeding with the order. The approved sample will serve as the standard for the subsequent frames.

- b) Frames must be supplied in strict accordance with the approved sample and all technical specifications outlined in the tender document. This includes but is not limited to font details, theme details, material quality, dimensions, design elements, and image printing quality.
- c) Frames must align precisely with the details specified in the reference drawing provided. Any discrepancies will result in rejection.
- d) Frames must exhibit high-quality craftsmanship and materials suitable for national importance. They should be scratch-free, dust free, and free from any marks or blemishes.
- e) Frames and accompanying coin packing materials must be thoroughly inspected for scratches, dust, thumb marks, or any other marks during final packing with commemorative coins.
- f) Frames should be visually appealing and enhance the presentation of the commemorative coins. Any deviations from the approved sample or quality standards will result in rejection.

7) Delivery Terms:

- a) Overall contract period will be 1 year from the date of PO.
- b) The material is required to be supplied throughout 1 year on 'as and when required' basis.
- c) Supplier shall be intimated for the commemorative coin theme & design of the frames as and when required.
- d) Minimum Order Quantity per theme is 1 no.
- e) The firm will be given a lead time of 7 days from the date of intimation and/or design confirmation by IGMH (whichever is later). Thereafter, the firm has to supply the frames at a rate of 10 nos. per day.
 - e.g. if order Qty. 1 - 10 nos. -- Delivery period is 7+1 = 8 days
 - e.g. for order Qty. 11 - 20 nos. -- Delivery period is 7+1+1 = 9 days.

Note:

The procurement will be on rate contract basis & during the entire contract period rates will be fixed. The quantity mentioned is tentative & may change as per requirement of IGMH. It is also to mention that all the quantity mentioned may not be necessarily exhausted.

B) Technical Specifications for 300 No's Executive stand:(Majorly consists of Inner body and Outer Case)

1) Materials:

- a) The inner body shall comprise a black acrylic base made in three (3) steps with approx. 10 mm thickness each. All the dimensions are mentioned in the drawing (The reference drawing is uploaded separately in Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC of the document).
- b) The outer case shall be made of dome shaped acrylic sheet with approx. 4 mm thickness covering the main stand as well as the topmost step of the black base.
- c) Coin mounting sheet (dome-shaped) shall be of 4mm acrylic coloured sheet (preferably milky white colour acrylic sheet for design and UV printing) with a provision of one cavity to accommodate one commemorative coin of size 44.10-44.15mm.
- d) 3mm transparent acrylic sheets (dome-shaped) similar to coin mounting sheet, to be provided to cover the coin mounting sheet from both sides, thereby protecting the commemorative coins from dust and scratches.
- e) Transparent acrylic dome shaped enclosure (4mm thick) to secure the coin mounting sheet and has to be fastened with suitable mechanism to the base.
- f) Base: Strong base for versatile display on a table. Also, two black acrylic strips shall be glued on either s

ide of the middle step of the base, bearing the title 'INDIA GOVERNMENT MINT, HYDERABAD' in Hindi on one side and in English on the other side.

g) The executive stand shall be manufactured & supplied with high finish quality and without any scratch/cut marks and/or other defects etc. The executive stands shall be supplied in proper packing so as to ensure no damage during transportation

2) Image and text matter to be printed:

a) The print design shall be provided by IGMH in PDF format, i.e. the design matter, UV portion, Laser cutting drawing for cavity, shall be provided in 3 separate pages.

b) The design print and UV print should match exactly, with no visible overlaps and printing errors etc.

c) The color of the coin mounting sheet should match exactly as per the design provided by IGMH.

3) Executive Stand Design:

a) The executive stand design should be simple and elegant, complementing the commemorative coin.

b) The cavity to accommodate the commemorative coin must be cut on laser cutting machine to ensure clean finish, the location and size shall be as per the design.

c) Incorporate a scratch-free and scratch-resistant transparent acrylic dome shaped enclosure to allow easy viewing of the commemorative coins.

d) Once the commemorative coin is placed, they remain secure and do not rotate.

4) Dimensions:

a) The executive stand dimensions should adhere to the provided reference drawing, with accommodation of one commemorative coin.

b) Coin compartments: Dimensions to precisely fit the specific commemorative coins.

5) Additional Requirements:

a) Proper packing of the commemorative coin in executive stand and final delivery packing with bubble wrapping are the supplier's responsibility.

b) Commemorative coins shall be fitted in the premises of IGMH.

c) All the required packing material for final packing including bubble wrapping of the executive stands has to be arranged by the firm.

6) Acceptance Criteria:

a) The first sample of complete executive stand provided by the supplier must be approved before proceeding with the order. The approved sample will serve as the standard for the subsequent executive stands.

b) Executive stands must be supplied in strict accordance with the approved sample and all technical specifications outlined in the tender document. This includes but is not limited to font details, theme details, material quality, dimensions, design elements, and image printing quality.

c) Executive stands must align precisely with the details specified in the reference drawing provided. Any discrepancies will result in rejection.

d) Executive stands must exhibit high-quality craftsmanship and materials suitable for national importance. They should be scratch-free, dust free, and free from any marks or blemishes.

e) Executive stands and accompanying coin packing materials must be thoroughly inspected for scratches, dust, thumb marks, or any other marks during final packing with commemorative coins.

f) Executive stands should be visually appealing and enhance the presentation of the commemorative coins. Any deviations from the approved sample or quality standards will result in rejection.

7) Delivery Terms:

- a) Overall contract period will be 1 year from the date of PO.
- b) The material is required to be supplied throughout 1 year on 'as and when required' basis.
- c) Supplier shall be intimated for the commemorative coin theme & design of the executive stands as and when required.
- d) Minimum Order Quantity per theme is 5 nos.
- e) The firm will be given a lead time of 7 days from the date of intimation and/or design confirmation by IGMH (whichever is later). Thereafter, the firm has to supply the executive stands at a rate of 10 nos. per day.

e.g. if order Qty. 5 - 10 nos. -- Delivery period is $7+1 = 8$ days

e.g. if order Qty. 11 - 20 nos. -- Delivery period is $7+1+1 = 9$ days.

Note:

The procurement will be on rate contract basis & during the entire contract period rates will be fixed. The quantity mentioned is tentative & may change as per requirement of IGMH. It is also to mention that all the quantity mentioned may not be necessarily exhausted.

Eligibility:

(a) For MSE/Start-up firm: Capability - Equipment & Manufacturing Facilities: The bidder firm should have capability to manufacture and supply of tendered item.
