1. Scope of Supply

The scope of supply shall include supply, transportation, installation, testing, commissioning, of one number Precision Surface Grinding Machine complete in all respects. The bidder shall supply all standard accessories, tooling, electrical equipment, coolant system, dust exhaust system, mandatory spare parts and safety accessories required for satisfactory operation of the machine. Any item not specifically mentioned but essential for safe, reliable and efficient functioning of the machine shall be deemed included in the scope of supply without any additional cost. The Surface grinding machine should be capable for grinding of components made of Nickel based alloys, stainless steel and titanium alloys. This should be strong and rigid to ensure vibration free operation for achieving high accuracy and surface finish of components machined. The equipment should be generally confirming to the following specifications.

Duty: The machine should be designed for continuous use for minimum 2 shifts (8 hours each)

3. Quality, Training & Acceptance Terms

3.1 Installation & Commissioning: The firm is responsible for the complete installation and commissioning at the buyer's site (IGMH).

i) The Surface Grinding Machine should be offered to IGMH for pre-dispatch inspection before final supply. Intimation for PDI must be given minimum one week prior to the scheduled date of dispatch from supplier site.

ii) During PDI, following activities will be carried out:

a) Verification of basic parameters of equipment, with respect to the specifications.

b) Inspection & performance testing of equipment as per approved specification.

Note: IGMH reserves the right to waive off the pre-dispatch Inspection.

3.3 Training: 1-week comprehensive Operation and Maintenance Training for IGMH employees at site to minimum 4 no of employees.

3.4 Performance Trial: Final acceptance is subject to a 2-week continuous trial operation at IGMH post commissioning. Suitability will be given after successful completion of Performance trial.

3.5 Warranty & Spare Parts: Minimum 1 year comprehensive warranty and 10 years guaranteed availability of spare parts from the date of issue of suitability.

4. General terms & conditions

1. EQUIPMENT IDENTIFICATION DETAILS:

The Surface Grinding Machine should be fitted permanently with a nameplate at a visible place. The following information should be etched / engraved on the nameplate.

- i) Nomenclature
- ii) Model Number
- iii) Month and Year of manufacture
- iv) Manufacturer's name
- v) Serial No.
- vi) Supply order no. and date
- vii) Origin

5. DOCUMENTATION:

i) 2 sets of hard copies and soft copy of the following documents in English are to be supplied along with the equipment:

- a) Operator manual.
- b) Spare part list.
- c) Maintenance manual.
- d) Electrical wiring diagram.
- e) Preventive maintenance check list, troubleshooting charts and guidelines.
- f) Equipment test charts.
- g) Document of all bought out items.

ii) Technical literature / catalogue (in English) illustrating the design and operation of the Surface Grinding Machine and accessories should be forwarded along with machine.

6. INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING:

i) The Surface Grinding Machine shall be supplied, installed & commissioned by the supplier within 60 days after receipt of Contract/PO.

ii) The Surface Grinding Machine will be inspected by our representatives at our site during Commissioning and Installation.

iii) Necessary tests required for confirming the performance of equipment, should be demonstrated to IGMH's engineers for acceptance.

iv) Civil job for foundation, cable trench, if required, shall be in the scope of IGMH. However, foundation drawing should be provided to IGMH by the vendor within one month of placement of PO.

7. TRAINING:

i) Training on operation and maintenance to be imparted to our personnel during delivery.

ii) The supplier has to provide training to our engineers in the following areas for a period of 1 week at IGMH site during commissioning in the following areas;

- a) Equipment operation.
- b) Mechanical & electrical maintenance including safety.

8. SPECIAL NOTE:

- i) Provide line wise compliance/ non-compliance against each parameter.
- ii) Provide numerical values wherever applicable.
- iii) Parameters are Essential in nature. Offers not meeting essential parameters will not be Considered. However, specification offered on higher/better side may be considered during Technical evaluation.

II. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OR QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

The bidder firm should meet following eligibility criteria to qualify:

- (a) For MSE/Start-up firm: Capability - Equipment & Manufacturing Facilities:

The bidder firm should have capability to manufacture and supply of tendered item.

The bidder firm may be Manufacturer/Proven supplier/Authorized dealer or distributor of tendered item or bidder may participate with manufacturing authorization form (issued by manufacturer of tendered item).

12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1

bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
